



Dear Parents and Carers

Each year, children from schools across the ATLP are chosen to be given special awards. There are 6 categories of award and as a school we will shortlist one child from each category to be nominated to receive an award. The award winners get to go to Drayton Manor for the day with one member of their family, attend an award ceremony, have lunch and gain access to all the rides at Drayton Manor. We would like you to nominate your child for any of the below categories.

The six categories are detailed below:

<b>CATEGORY</b>	<b>CHARACTERISTICS</b>
<b>Special Endeavour</b>	This is awarded to a pupil who has overcome a difficulty, which might be related to a personal matter, physical or emotional issues e.g. someone who has struggled with ill health.
<b>Community</b>	This is awarded to a pupil for their contributions outside of school that have made a difference to their community e.g. someone who has volunteered at a club, volunteers for a charity or who looks after and supports a vulnerable person.
<b>Extra-Curricular</b>	This is awarded to a pupil who is committed to extra-curricular activities through either regular attendance or helping to run and organise the activity e.g. School team umpire.
<b>Contribution to School Life</b>	This is awarded to a pupil who has made a significant contribution to school life over the last year e.g. someone who is a member of the school council, a prefect or other leadership role.
<b>Charity Fundraiser</b>	This is awarded to a pupil who has raised a significant sum of money for charity e.g. sponsored silence, organising a cake sale or taking part in a fun run.
<b>Creativity</b>	This is awarded to a pupil who has displayed exceptional creativity either as an artist, musical performer, actor, writer, poet or dancer.
