The Prom is being held in Aston Villa's Terrace View. The nearest car park is the Holte Car Park, located on the Holte Stand, Trinity Road, B6 6HE. Arrival is from **19.30**, the event finishes promptly at **23.00**. Please ensure that students have arranged how they are getting home.

Whilst it is always wonderful for students, staff, parents and families to greet the students arriving and take photos, only those who have purchased a ticket will be able to access the prom.

Aston Villa is a prestigious venue and their event security is a priority. Therefore, students should not bring any prohibited items with them, this includes vapes. Should students leave the event they will not be granted readmittance.

The venue is cashless and the bar will remain closed. The meal is served as a buffet, with unlimited squash and water provided which is included in the cost of the ticket.

Return of iPads, Cases, Chargers, Cables, Stylus, lead and charger adapter

We kindly request your attention regarding the return of school-issued iPads (including the case and charging cable/plug) and stylus (including the charger/adapter). It is essential that these items are returned promptly and in good condition.

Students are welcome to return the above items from week commencing **10 June 2024**. They can bring them to Main Reception.







We will however be holding 2 specific returns session in the hall for students in school on **Friday 14 June 2024.** If your child has a Geography exam in the morning, they can return their device after the exam has finished. There will also be a session at **12:00pm** for students coming in for the Physics exam in the afternoon.

If they do not have all the items listed above with them they should return the items to Mrs Fahy via the Main Reception before **Friday 21 June 2024.** It is important to emphasise that, if students do not return their school iPad, case, charger, stylus, cable and adapter by **Friday 21 June 2024**, ATLP may seek to recover any costs incurred. Failure to do so can also result in us not releasing your exam results and certificates.

Device Condition: To ensure a smooth return process, the iPad must be charged to a minimum of 50% before returning it. All items must be handed in at the same time and be free from any stickers and ink. All items will be passed on for other students to use and therefore need to be in a good condition.

Verification Process: A member of staff will be present to check each device and record that all the required items have been returned. This verification is crucial to maintain an accurate inventory and to avoid any misunderstandings.

We kindly ask for your cooperation in adhering to the return procedure. By returning these items promptly and in good condition, you will help ensure future students can benefit from the use of these resources.
