Dear Parents and Carers

We have a number of students experiencing symptoms associated with a stomach bug and we have taken the decision to close the school to allow for deep cleaning to take place and to prevent further spread of illness. We are unsure whether the stomach bug originated in our school. The school will reopen as normal on Monday 9 December 2024.

We are very grateful for the support in helping us reduce the spread of infection. Just a reminder, If your child has symptoms of diarrhoea and or vomiting, please keep them at home until 48 hours after they are feeling better.

What work can students do while we are closed?

Teachers will upload lessons to Showbie throughout the day for students to complete. These lessons will reflect their normal timetable, so students should log into these classes.
